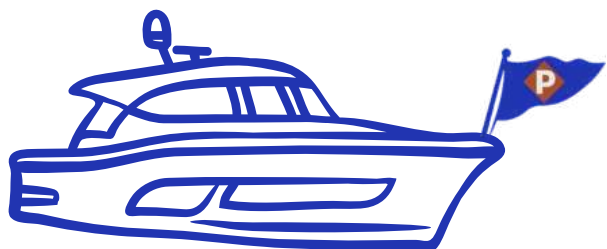
It is August, and it's time to appreciate all that we have done this year. Your board has worked very hard to entertain and create togetherness, and with the help of the members, we have been very successful at this.

**Hello Fellow PYC Family,**

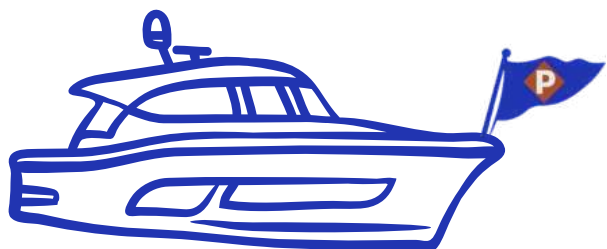
This month has been busy with smaller maintenance tasks.

**Bicycle Safety**



*Always inspect your bike prior to riding!*

- The seat should be adjusted to the proper height and locked in place
- Make certain all parts are secure and working properly
- Check that the tires are inflated properly
- Make sure the bike is equipped with reflectors on the rear, front, pedals and spokes
- Wear neon, fluorescent or other bright clothing
- Whenever possible, ride during the day
- If you must ride at night, wear reflective clothing and use flashing lights

## CA State Boating Laws & Regulations

***Alert: Effective January 1, 2024***

***Are you 60 years of age or younger?***

All motorized vessel operators 60 and younger are required by law to complete a boating safety course and obtain a California Boater Card before heading out on the water.

For more information about the California Boater Card, list of approved courses and exemptions, please visit [CaliforniaBoaterCard.com](http://CaliforniaBoaterCard.com).

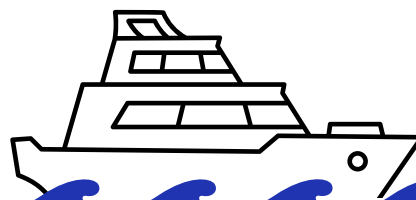
A California Boater Card can be obtained online at any age. However, California Boater Card age requirements prohibit anyone under 16 years of age from operating a boat or Personal Watercraft with a motor larger than 15 horsepower, with the exception of sailboats under 30 feet in length and dinghys between moored boats or between a moored boat and the shoreline.


California boaters between the ages of 12 and 15 may operate boats with motors over 15 horsepower if supervised by an adult 18 or older in possession of a boater card.

By 2025, boat operators of all ages will be required to possess a valid California Boater Card.

California Harbors and Navigation Code Section 678.11(b) contains the following phase-in schedule based on operator age (effective January 1st of each year):

- 2018:** Persons 20 years of age or younger
- 2019:** Persons 25 years of age or younger
- 2020:** Persons 35 years of age or younger
- 2021:** Persons 40 years of age or younger
- 2022:** Persons 45 years of age or younger
- 2023:** Persons 50 years of age or younger
- 2024:** Persons 60 years of age or younger
- 2025:** **All persons regardless of age**





# National Lighthouse Day

A **lighthouse** is described as a tower, building or any other type of structure that is designed to emit light from a system of lamps and lenses and used as an aid to navigation for maritime pilots at sea or on inland waterways.

## FUN FACTS

- The first ever lighthouse was Egypt's Pharos of Alexandria, built in 3rd century BC - featuring a fire on a platform to signal the port entrance
- The US is home to more lighthouses than anywhere else
- in the US, Michigan boasts the most lighthouses than any other State, with more than 115 along the Great Lakes
- Lighthouse keeping was one of the first US Government jobs available to women
- The first lighthouse to use electricity was the Statue of Liberty in 1886
